Significant Construction Detour Highway 1 Eastbound at 152 Street

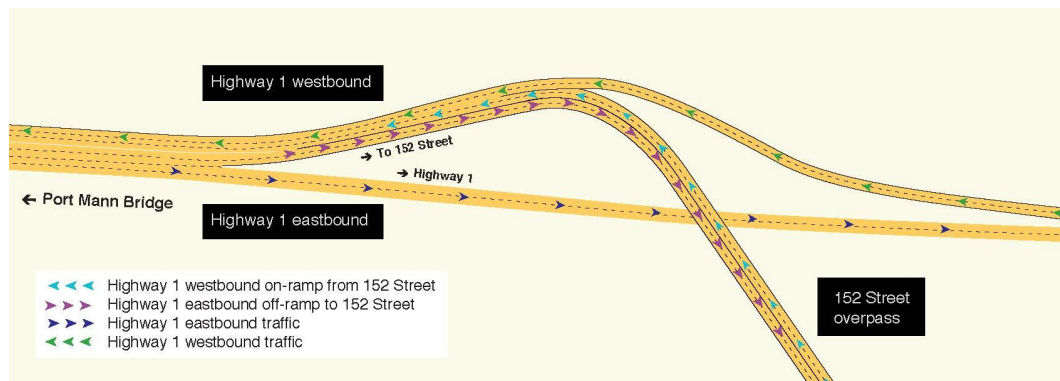
Beginning on January 21, 2012 (weather dependent) drivers on Highway 1 eastbound will see a significant traffic pattern change between the Port Mann Bridge and 152 Street in Surrey. **Traffic exiting at 152 Street will do so from the left, rather than the right.**

This traffic pattern change is necessary to construct the new 152 Street exit, additional highway lanes, and drainage systems on the south side of Highway 1. This configuration will be in place until summer 2012.

What to expect:

- Drivers exiting the highway at 152 Street will use the left lane to access the temporary off-ramp to Surrey.
- The left two lanes must exit at this point. Highway 1 through traffic should be in the right two lanes.
- Drivers will then use two lanes on the newly constructed 152 Street overpass as part of this detour (*please see the diagram below*). Please note that these two lanes will eventually be used as westbound lanes in the final configuration of the interchange.
- Pavement markings and overhead guide signs will be implemented on the Port Mann Bridge and Highway 1 to direct drivers to the appropriate lane.

In order to avoid congestion and to maintain safe traffic flow, drivers are asked to watch for and obey all new directional signs and merge at the appropriate time. Trucks will be merging out of the left hand lanes. Please obey all posted construction speeds and allow for safe and courteous merging. Traffic fines double in construction zones.



A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. PMH1 Improvements to the 152 Street Interchange include:

- New four-lane on-ramp for westbound traffic (two local-connection lanes and two through-traffic lanes) onto the bridge and off the bridge.
- New local-connection lanes (two in each direction) on the new Port Mann Bridge will provide significant improvements for vehicles travelling between Coquitlam and Surrey.
- New pedestrian/cyclist features: overpass near 112 Avenue, sidewalk along 152 Street that will connect to 110 Avenue and new off-road connection between 110 Avenue and 108 Avenue.
- Newly constructed off-ramp for Highway 1 eastbound traffic exiting to 152 Street.
- Two extra lanes in each direction on Highway 1.
