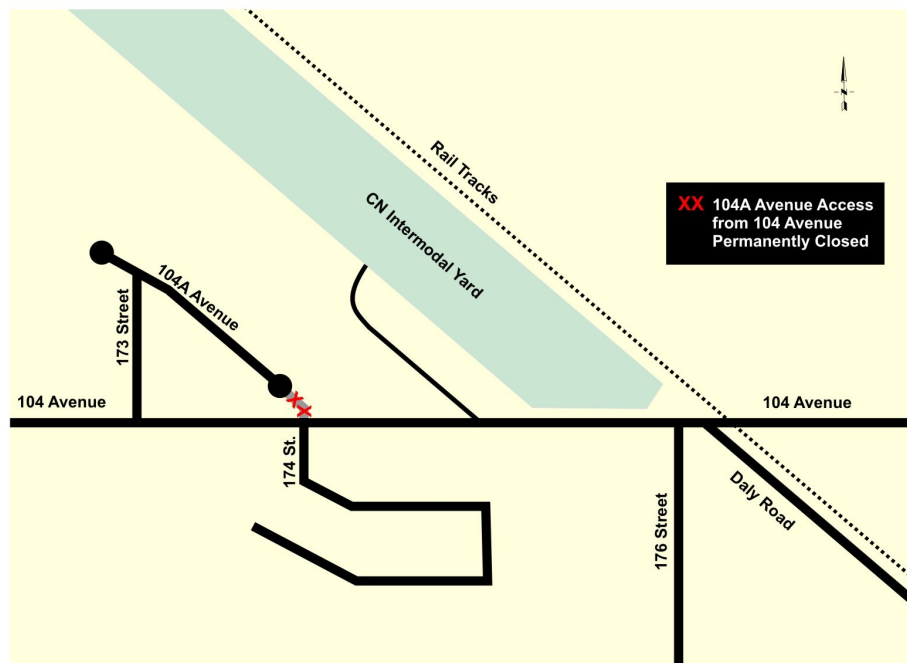


CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

Upcoming Permanent Closure of 104A Avenue Access from 104 Avenue in Surrey

On February 1, access to 104A Avenue from 104 Avenue will be permanently closed (*shown on the map below*). This closure is required for the construction of the new intersection at 104 Avenue/176 Street and the future connection to the South Fraser Perimeter Road (SFPR—see page 2). Drivers wishing to access to 104A Avenue will do so from 173 Street.



This area is a major hub for regional traffic and a number of improvements are planned for the surrounding road network to create more efficient connections between Highway 15, Highway 1, the SFPR and the Golden Ears Connector.

The SFPR is a new, four-lane highway that will run along the south side of the Fraser River from Deltaport Way in southwest Delta to 176 Street in Surrey. The section of the SFPR from 176 Street to the Pattullo Bridge is scheduled 136 Street is anticipated to be complete in late 2012.

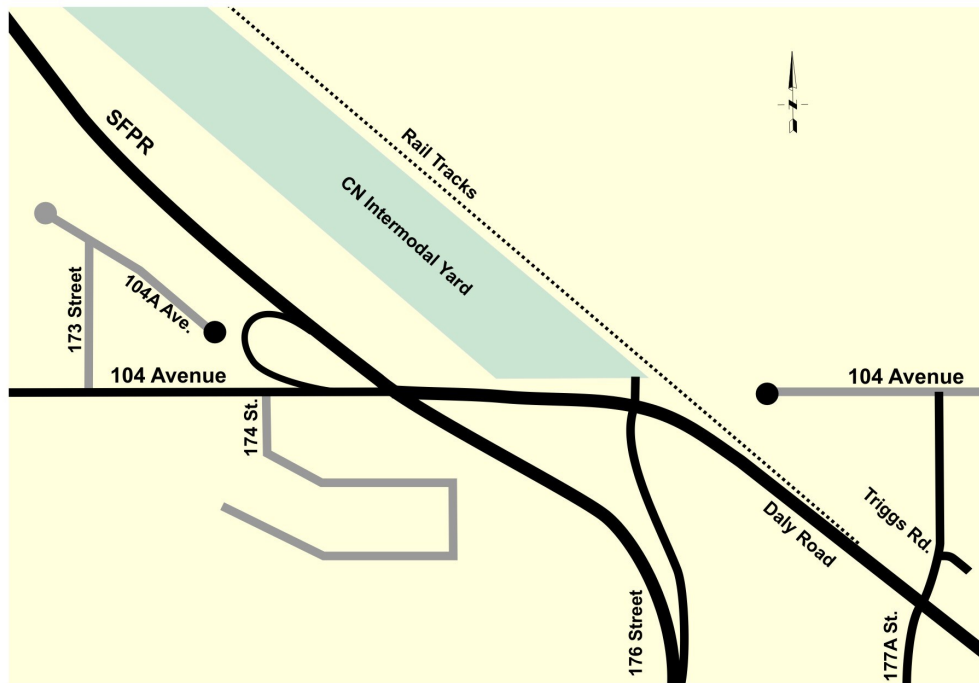
