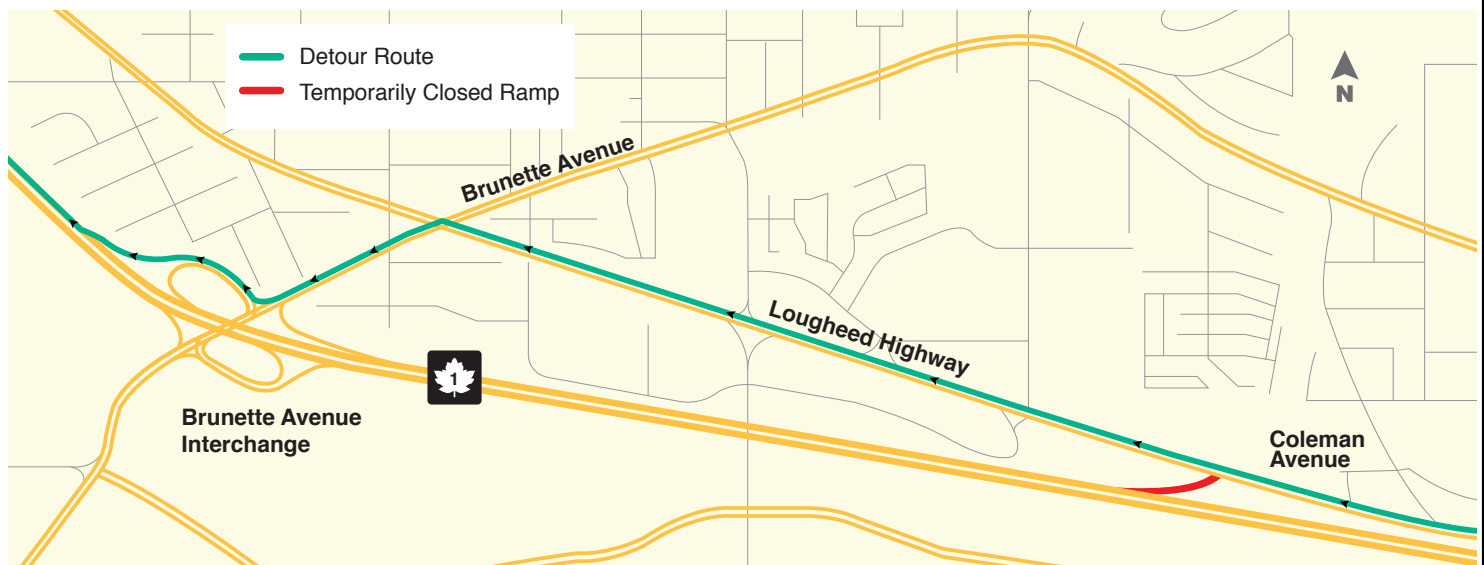


CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

Temporary Closure of Highway 1 Westbound On-Ramp from Lougheed Highway at Coleman Avenue

Beginning **Friday, August 6 at 10 p.m.** until Monday, August 9 at 5 a.m., motorists are advised that the Highway 1 westbound on-ramp at Coleman Avenue from Lougheed Highway will be temporarily closed. Motorists accessing Highway 1 westbound will continue on Lougheed Highway and use the Brunette Avenue on-ramp as shown on the map below.



This temporary closure is required for crews to construct future Highway 1 westbound lanes in this area.

The detour will be well-signed and drivers are asked to obey all posted construction speeds and watch for construction information signs and flag persons. Drivers are reminded that traffic fines double in construction zones.

A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
